PARENT/GUARDIAN: PLEASE KEEP THIS FOR YOUR RECORDS

Class 1 and Class 2 offenses will not be combined in the total number of write-ups a student receives. Consequences will be determined by the number of write-ups per category. However, a student may receive more than 1 write-up per incident.

The **Bus Behavior Guidelines and Consequences** are listed below.

Class 1 Offenses Including, But Not Limited To:

- 1. Failing to face forward
- 2. Failing to keep aisle clear
- 3. Failing to remain seated when bus in motion
- 4. Failing to use quiet voice when talking (used outside voice)
- 5. Eating or drinking on bus
- 6. Engaging in horseplay
- 7. Riding unassigned bus without permission
- 8. Making excessive noise
- 9. Riding or attempting to ride any bus after receiving a bus suspension

Class 1 Consequences

- 1. 1st Offense Warning with parent contacted by Director of Transportation
- 2. 2nd Offense Bus suspension of 1 day with parent contacted by Director of Transportation
- 3. 3rd Offense Bus suspension of 2 to 3 days with parent contacted by Principal
- 4. 4th Offense Bus suspension of 4 to 5 days with parent contacted by Principal
- 5. 5th Offense Bus suspension of 5 day minimum (PK-5) or 10 day minimum (6-12) & parent meeting with Principal
- 6. 6th Offense Loss of bus service for 1 six week period & parent meeting with Principal
- 7. 7th Offense Loss of bus service for 2 six week periods & meeting with Principal

Class 2 Offenses Including, But Not Limited To:

- 1. Disrespecting the Driver
- 2. Bullying
- 3. Failing to keep body/objects inside bus
- 4. Holding or attempting to hold any portion of the exterior of bus
- 5. Engaging in inappropriate physical contact or public display of affection
- 6. Inciting violence
- 7. Possessing lighters, matches, fireworks, or any flammable object or substance
- 8. Using profanity, obscene gestures, or possessing unacceptable material including pornography
- 9. Exhibiting physical aggression or threatening others
- 10. Tampering with bus equipment or vandalizing bus
- 11. Spitting

- 12. Throwing/shooting of any object
- 13. Entering or leaving bus through emergency door without authorization
- 14. Stealing or vandalizing property of others

Class 2 Consequences

- 1. 1st Offense Bus suspension of 1 day (PK-5) or 3 days (6-12) with parent contacted by Director of Transportation
- 2. 2nd Offense Bus suspension of 3 days (PK-5) or 5 days (6-12) with parent contacted by Principal
- 3. 3^{rd} Offense Bus suspension of 5 days (PK-5) or 7 days (6-12) & parent meeting with Principal
- 4th Offense Bus suspension of 7 days or possible loss of bus service (PK-5) or 10 days (6-12) or possible loss of bus service (6-12) & parent meeting with Principal
- 5. 5^{th} Offense Loss of bus service minimum of two 6 weeks & meeting with principal

Class 3 Offenses & Consequences

- 1. Possession of alcohol, drug paraphernalia or drugs immediate bus suspension of 3 days
- 2. Fighting immediate bus suspension of 3 days

Misconduct will be punished in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct; bus-riding privileges may be suspended.
